Celebrate Public Power Week with Klickitat PUD

Klickitat PUD celebrates Public Power Week, October 2 through 8, along with more than 2,000 other communityowned electric utilities.

Together they are referred to as the public power system, and collectively provide electricity on a not-for-profit basis to 48 million Americans.

"Public Power Week celebrates the reliable, affordable electricity Klickitat PUD provides throughout the county," says Ray Mosbrucker, president of the Klickitat PUD Board of Commissioners. "Public power puts the people of Klickitat County first, and Public Power Week gives us the chance to emphasize the advantages of locally grown, locally owned power that supports strong communities."

Public Power Week, which was first celebrated in 1986, is a national, annual event sponsored in conjunction with the American Public Power Association in Washington, D.C.

"We are proud to have served Klickitat County for 78 years and to be a public power county," Ray says. "Our focus goes beyond serving customers. We serve the communities we live in. For us, the hard work is rewarding since our customers are our neighbors and friends."

Klickitat PUD invites community members to participate in a variety of Public Power Week events. Activities include open houses at KPUD offices, winter weatherization and rebate workshops, and Operation Warm Heart information. Sign-up prizes are available all week. There will be activities for kids ranging from the interactive power safety and energy-saving show and games to becoming Junior Power Posse members. They can take the power pledge to help stop energy waste in the home. Open houses are Tuesday, October 4, from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., at the White Salmon office, and Friday, October 7 from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. at the Goldendale office.

Today, Klickitat PUD has 85 employees and owns the H.W. Hill Landfill Gas Power Plant, a 13 percent share of the White Creek Wind I Farm output, and 50 percent of the McNary Hydroelectric Fishway Project in conjunction with Northern Wasco PUD.

Approximately 10,744 residential, 1,939 commercial and two large industrial customers make up our customer base. Our service territory includes 1,341 miles of overhead distribution, 312 miles of underground distribution line, 203 miles of transmission line, and ownership of 23 substations. Also included in our business portfolio are 10 water and six wastewater systems throughout the county, owned and/or operated by Klickitat PUD.
