# GENERAL MANAGER'S REPORT TO THE BOARD

For the May 11, 2021 Meeting

#### **AGENDA ITEMS:**

- **A.** <u>2021 Physical Inventory update</u> Jeff Thayer will provide an update on the April inventory process that was just completed. With staff availability, work load and weather all working in our favor, April was a good time to complete inventory. Also the change to relieving inventory daily, not waiting until the job is complete has had a very positive impact on this process.
- **B.** <u>Prequalification of Contractors</u> Jeff Thayer will also be asking that we add NW Utility Services, LLC to the Small and Large works rosters for the 2021 period.
- **C.** Call for Bid- Echo Glenn to Bristol Rd rebuild Mark Garner is asking for approval of a Call for Bid for the Echo Glen to Bristol Road rebuild project. The White Salmon engineers have staked the project, we know that with the extended material lead time construction will not happen before fall.
- **D.** <u>Large Load discussion</u> Ron Schultz, Mark Garner, Brandon Johnson and Mike DeMott will provide an update on large load interconnection requests.
- **E.** <u>Customer Assistance Program funding proposals</u> Brandy Myers will discuss the customer assistance proposals that were submitted with the grant funding application. With the pending award, we want to be prepared to roll out the programs as soon as possible.
- **F.** <u>Water/Wastewater Rate discussion</u> Jim Smith and Sharon Blodgett will discuss potential direction for 2021 rate adjustments.

#### **NON-AGENDA ITEMS:**

1. <u>Vegetation Management</u> - Last meeting Commissioner Knowles asked about vegetation management completed in 2020. Staff has been working on building a map to allow us to better track our work. Mark Pritchard and April Greenlaw will be available to run through the preliminary version of that mapping system.
