


## Bobby Koffler Joins KPUD Tree Crew

### Klickitat PUD Fuel Mix Report

The Washington Department of Community, Trade and Economic Development ("CTED") conducts an annual survey of all electric utilities operating within the state to determine the generation source of the electric energy sold to the utilities' retail customers.

CTED uses this information to develop a statewide database and subsequently provides each electric utility with a "Fuel Mix Report" listing the fuel types used in providing their electric service.
