## Don't Let Pipes Freeze

Frozen water pipes are inconvenient and costly to repair.

Here are Klickitat PUD Water/Wastewater Department recommendations to prevent frozen pipes and thaw those that already are frozen.

- ▶ Let water from a faucet run at a slow, constant drip during extreme cold temperatures. This is cheaper than facing a repair bill.
- ▶ Remember to insulate all water pipes from cold moving air and keep them dry.
- ▶ To thaw a frozen pipe, heat the area around the frozen part with an electric space heater, a hand-held hair dryer or a heat lamp. If this is a problem, call a plumber.

## Energy-Saving Rebates Available

Klickitat PUD offers customers a way to weatherize their homes in any energy-saving and cost-efficient way with its Conservation Rate Credit Program.

This program offers rebates to customers in a variety of categories, including appliances (clothes washers), air-to-air heat pumps, duct sealing, insulation, windows, solar installation, irrigation (pump motors and sprinkler parts) and commercial lighting.

There is also the KPUD Loan Program for any item that qualifies for a rebate. Items that qualify are eligible for a loan at 4.9-percent financing. Loans are issued from \$1,000 to \$10,000 to customers in good standing.
