### GENERAL MANAGER'S REPORT TO THE BOARD

For the March 14, 2023 Meeting

## **AGENDA ITEMS:**

- **A.** Prequalification of Professional Services Consultants Brandon Johnson will be requesting approval of the two professional service firms. They have met the requirements to be added to the roster for the 2023 period.
- **B.** Policy 43 Large End User Interconnection The engineering group is bringing proposed changes to align the wording of the policy to reference the current versions of NERC FAC's and internal policies.
- C. Policy 16 Line Extension The engineering group is bringing proposed changes to accommodate undergrounding for new services in designated areas.
- **D.** Acknowledgement of MA Collins Construction Contract Award The engineering group has completed the evaluation of the bids received and will provide you with the information used to make the determination of awarding the contract to Palouse Power.
- **E.** Prequalification of Contractors Jeff Thayer is requesting board approval to add Proper Plumbing to the small works roster for the 2023 period.
- F. Energy Northwest Small Modular Nuclear Reactor Project update Greg Cullen, Energy Northwest's Vice President for Energy Services/Development and Jason Herbert, Energy Northwest's Senior Director of External Strategy/New Nuclear Development will be on site to discuss progress on their clean energy project with X-energy.

#### **NON-AGENDA ITEMS:**

- 1. <u>Landfill Gas Improvement Fund contracts</u> We have received the approved LFG funding assistance agreements from the county. They have requested that we review and sign the documents so they can be executed.
- 2. <u>Review of active Bills in Olympia</u> I will review active bills and we can discuss what you are hearing as well.
- 3. <u>Community Meetings</u> Attached is the tentative meeting schedule. Luann is still working with communities to confirm times. Please review and we can plan for meetings you would like to attend.
- 4. <u>2022 Capital Budget Carry Over to 2023</u> Jeff Thayer reports that Four vehicles were carried over from 2022 to 2023 due to ongoing supply chain issues. The total is \$470,000. Jeff included these funds in the 2023 operating budget. All four have been ordered. He does anticipate that our costs will be about 10% over budget to put all four in service.
  - I will update you on the status of any carried over capital items on the construction side once we compile the data for you.
- 5. <u>Coffee with Retirees</u> I was really pleased we finally got together after COVID and such. Eight retired employees showed up between White Salmon and Goldendale. Great meeting with some fine people and good ambassadors in our community.
