The Klickitat Public Utility District is pleased to announce that as of 7:30 a.m. on November 2, 2018, the H.W. Hill Renewable Natural Gas Project located at the Republic Services Regional Landfill in Roosevelt, Wash., has begun gas injection and sales into the Williams Northwest pipeline system.

Under a 15-year purchase and sales agreement with IGI Resources, a subsidiary of BP North America, the H.W. Hill Renewable Natural Gas project will be one of the largest and most efficient renewable natural gas (RNG) projects in the world. When used in place of conventional fossil transportation fuels, RNG produced from landfills has the lowest carbon emissions of any fuel. This includes carbon emissions attributed to electric vehicles.

Over the next several weeks, Klickitat PUD and its contractors will continue to optimize the new facility to maximize the efficiency and reliability of this project.

Klickitat PUD staff appreciates the continued public support for the facility and looks forward to its economic contribution to the utility's customers.

A public dedication ceremony is planned in the spring and Klickitat PUD staff is excited to present the new facility at that time.
