Incentives are based on the fiscal year in which the system is certified
Systems (up to 12kW) - Incentives capped at \$5,000 annually
2018 - \$0.16/kWh, with a \$0.05 Made-in-Washington solar panel bonus
2019 - \$0.14/kWh, with a \$0.04 Made-in-Washington solar panel bonus
2020 - \$0.12/kWh, with a \$0.03 Made-in-Washington solar panel bonus (MAY NOT BE AVAILABLE)
2021 - \$0.10/kWh, with a \$0.02 Made-in-Washington solar panel bonus (MAY NOT BE AVAILABLE)
Systems (12kW and up) - Incentives capped at \$25,000 annually
2018 - \$0.06/kWh, with a \$0.05 Made-in-Washington solar panel bonus
2019 - \$0.04/kWh, with a \$0.04 Made-in-Washington solar panel bonus
2020 - \$0.02/kWh, with a \$0.03 Made-in-Washington solar panel bonus (MAY NOT BE AVAILABLE)
2021 - \$0.02/kWh, with a \$0.02 Made-in-Washington solar panel bonus (MAY NOT BE AVAILABLE)
* Note: Washington State's fiscal year runs from July 1 - June 30

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ What are the program terms? The incentive payments run for 8 fiscal years or 96 months, or until cumulative incentive payments reach 50% of the total system price-whichever comes first. Annual limits will apply. ❖ When does enrolment end for new participants? June 30, 2021 or until State mandated caps are met ❖ How do I apply for the annual payment? KPUD will send you an annual application that must be submitted by August 1 ❖ What governs this program? Washington State legislation ESSB 5939 and is subject to changes.
